CODE OF CONDUCT

The TVWC Code of Conduct provides an ethical framework for all decisions, actions and behaviours of its members.

When undertaking activities associated with TVWC, all members must:

- Treat fellow members with courtesy and respect, without harassment and with proper regard for their rights and obligations as a volunteer.
- At all times behave honestly and with integrity.
- Comply with all applicable laws and licence agreements of the government of the day that relate to the rehabilitation of wildlife.
- Comply with the Constitution, Rules and Policies of the TVWC.
- Act only in the interests of the TVWC.
- Avoid any attempt to gain individual benefit or advantage.
- Recognize that properly constituted majority decisions are binding on all members.
- Disclose to the TVWC management committee any potential or actual conflict of interest in connection with TVWC activities.
- Utilise TVWC facilities and equipment for TVWC activities only, unless the TVWC management committee has granted prior approval.
- Provide true and unambiguous information, when requested.
- Provide public statements on behalf of the TVWC only with the prior approval of the TVWC management committee.
- Act with courtesy and respect to enhance the reputation of the TVWC when dealing with members of the public.
- Recognize that not adhering to the Code of Conduct could make the member liable to expulsion from the TVWC in accordance with Clause 6 of the Constitution.
